Covid Protocol when accessing Tobermory United Church

Maximum allowed in the church: 30 people

- Those attending will be asked to sanitize on the way in and on the way out of the building (it will be provided).
- Those attending worship will enter the pews by the centre aisle and exit the pews on the opposite end and exit the building through the main double doors that will be opened (back leaves first, single file).
- Everyone is asked to take their coats to their pew. No coats are to be hung up.
- Masks are required to be worn.
- Masks will be available for those who do not bring their own.
- A contact list will be maintained for each congregation and visitors throughout the week. Everyone must sign in and out for tracking purposes.
- Washrooms are available with hand sanitizing outside the washroom doors – wipes are available inside the washroom.
- There will be no coffee time prior or after the service.
- Attendees are asked to go directly to their pews and adhere to markings for where to sit.
- We ask that there be no wandering throughout the church to avoid touching and also coming in contact with other touchable surfaces.
- The social distancing requirement will be implemented in all parts of the church (no hugging). A distance of 2 meters is to be maintained.

Fogging the church

The fogging system has proven to be safe and a cost-effective way of disinfecting the church. Several folks have been trained on using the system. Fogging will happen before and after each service (Catholic and United) and after groups of 6 or more people have gathered in the church. ***Please notify Rob Groves if you are doing something at the church where 6 or more people will be in attendance so that fogging can be implemented following your meeting.*** (519) 379-2324 or rggroves@eastlink.ca
